



**FPPI-EXPORT POWER OF ATTORNEY**  
**FOR ELECTRONIC FILING OF SHIPPER'S EXPORT DECLARATION (SED)**  
**(FOREIGN PRINCIPAL PARTY IN INTEREST)/ FORWARDING AGENT**

appoints Cargo International Consolidators, Inc., of 2351 NW 121ct, Suite 115, Miami, Florida 33182 to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the Foreign Principal Party in Interest for and in the name, place and stead of the Foreign Principal Party in Interest, from this date, in the United States either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means to:

- Act as Forwarding Agent for Export Control, Census Reporting and Customs purpose.
- Prepare and electronically file an Automated Export System ("AES" also known as "AES Direct") filing in the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) which is operated by the U.S. Customs & Border Protection. The filing is on behalf of the FPPI, and the filing is of Electronic Export Information ("EEI") formerly filed on the Shipper's Export Declaration ("SED") and is required in connection with the exportation of any merchandise shipped or consigned by or to FPPI or FPPI's principal;
- FPPI acknowledges that necessary and proper documentation /information to accurately transmit Electronic Export Information via Automated Export System must be provided to CIC by the USPPI and/or other parties. The FPPI further acknowledges that in the event that such information/documentation is not provided by the USPPI after requests by CIC, that it will use the best efforts to have the USPPI provide this information as required by the Federal Trade Regulations.
- FPPI further understands that civil and criminal penalties may be imposed for making false or fraudulent statements or for the violation of any U.S. laws or regulations on exportation and agrees to be bound by all statements of CIC based upon information or documentation provided by FPPI to said authorized agent.

- Upon request, Forwarding Agent shall provide U.S. Principal Party in Interest ("USPPI") with a copy of this document or a copy of the data elements provided by the USPPI or both.
- It is clear that FPPI is located outside the United States and that any or all transactions handled by CIC under this power of attorney are "routed export transactions" as that term is defined in 15 C.F.R § 30.1 (Foreign Trade Regulations) and 15 C.F.R. part 772 (Export administration Regulations), FPPI certifies that it will not assume responsibility for licensing requirements and obtaining license authority without obtaining CIC's prior written consent.
- Giving to Forwarding Agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything required necessary to be done as fully as FPPI could do if present and acting, ratifying and confirming all that the Forwarding Agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of this authority.
- FPPI shall provide, or cause to be provided, to Forwarding Agent all information required by law or regulation and necessary for the proper preparation and submission of the EEI to the AES system, including all information necessary to enable Forwarding Agent properly to respond to all warning messages and fatal error messages received from the AES system;
- FPPI warrants that it has full power and authority to grant this power of attorney to Forwarding Agent;
- FPPI further warrants to Forwarding Agent that all information provided to Forwarding Agent for completion of EEIs submitted to the AES system will be true and correct to the best of FPPI's knowledge and belief and shall not, in any case, be false or fraudulent in violation of any United States laws or regulations.
- This power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given and received by Forwarding Agent. FPPI undertakes to determine any export licensing requirements, to obtain any export license or other official authorization, and to accomplish any Customs formalities other than filing SEDs for the export of goods.
- **FPPI further specifically agrees to indemnify and hold Forwarding Agent harmless from any damages, claims or liability (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses) arising out of or in connection with the performance of these powers by Forwarding Agent.**
